

Based on the latest update from the Massachusetts Drought Management Task Force, Nantucket is currently designated as Level 2 – Significant Drought Water Restrictions

Effective immediately, the following restrictions are in place under the Town's water withdrawal permit:

When Level 2 restrictions are in effect, customers are to practice voluntary water conservation and minimize overall water use.

Limit all non-essential outdoor use.

No automatic irrigation of any kind, including drip lines.

No watering except with a handheld hose or watering can after 5 PM or before 9 AM.

Fix indoor leaks promptly and avoid unnecessary water use. Check toilets, faucets, and showers.

Limit power washing of sidewalks and buildings.

Limit pool fills (call Wannacomet Water 508-228-0022)

Compliance with drought restrictions is not only required but vital to ensure that sufficient water remains available for residents, businesses, and emergency services.

We understand that water restrictions can be inconvenient, and we sincerely appreciate your cooperation and commitment to conservation.

The drought status will be reassessed at the end of each month. Residents and businesses are urged to conserve water and follow these restrictions to help protect the island's limited water supply.

Due to the severity of the drought currently affecting the island, the Nantucket Water Commission unanimously voted to impose fines on Town water customers who violate the mandatory use restrictions.

- 1st Offense – Warning
- 2nd Offense - \$250 Fine
- 3rd Offense - \$500 Fine
- 4th Offense – Property water will be shut off
